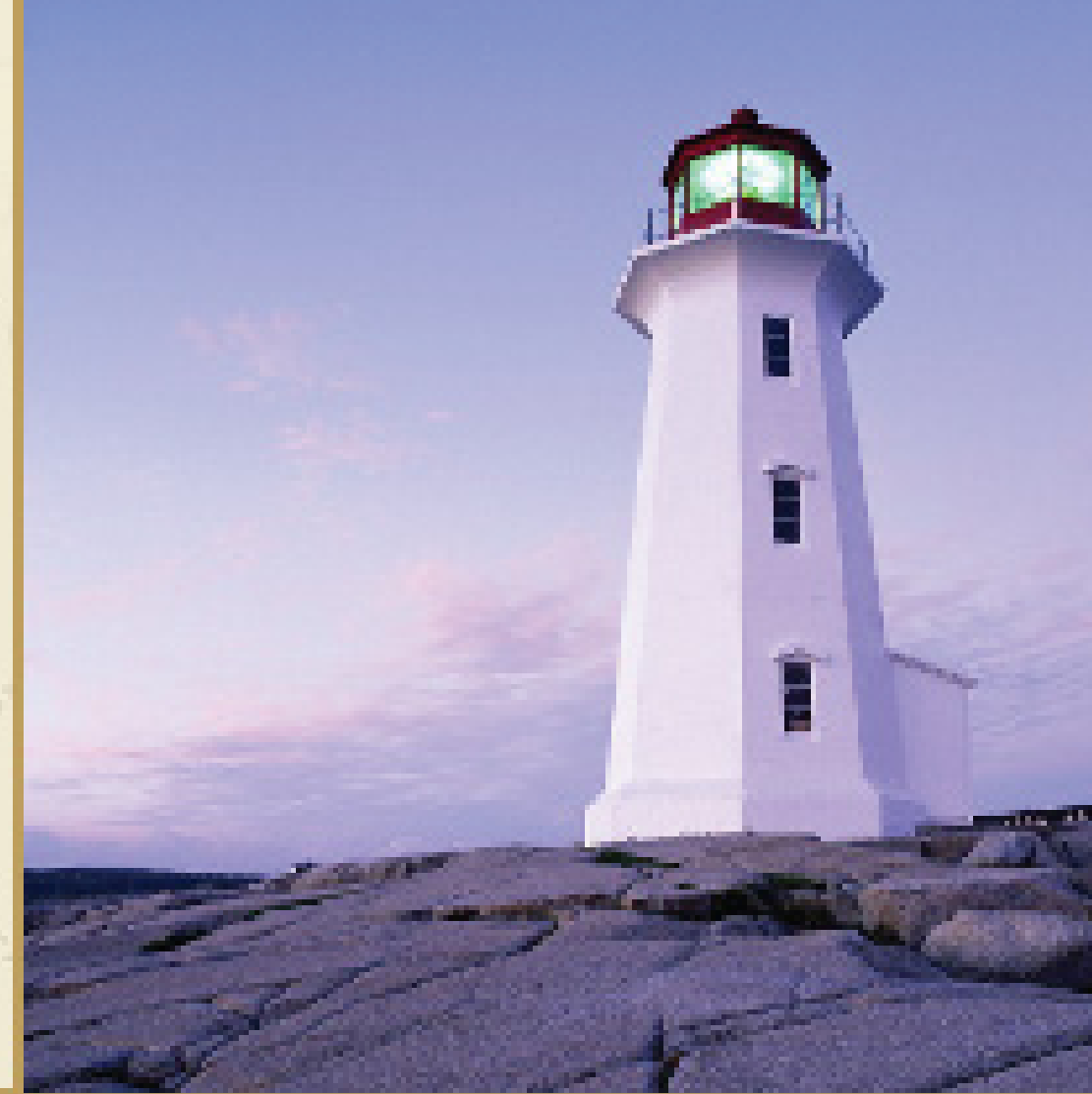

VI. OCCURRENCES:

A. Honduras: we are suffering difficult moments, we have been beat by Number 16 storm. It made more danger than the hurricane Mitch. Rivers and streams overflow, we had deaths. Landslides of the hills, danger in the sowing of corn, rice, beans. The roads, streets, ways intransitable, not in car or by horses. People are preoccupied because we are in extreme poverty, some of them lost their houses and all their things. Near to my house an small stream it had a incredible flowing and a man lost his life there, and some houses inundated.

B. Of cause of this situation we also suffered by the electricity we had no light for ten days. Some post of the light wire came down by the rivers flowing. Also we had difficulties with the water, it was a critical situation because we had not clean water, the trouble was for the water we use in the homes, and some times we suffer for thirst.

C. The violence in all the terms but it is exaggerated in my district. We had two cases of violent death and had robbery in the houses so the people were very scared.

D. A sister by faith is preoccupied because the river beat strong a ravine and now is very near to her house, she is afraid because if another flow comes her house will be destroyed, and our sister is very poor.
