

Pondering the Proverbs 21

How many times could any of us admit that we “put our foot” in our mouths? Sometimes we joke about the taste of boot leather or having an athletic shoe logo stamped on our tongues. Most all of us have suffered the embarrassment from over-reaction or being “too quick on the trigger” when we did not have all the facts. The horrible part is when we react in such a way as to drive another away and damage a relationship. Can we really learn to stop having verbal “accidents” and take control of the words we use? The Creator of the devices we use to communicate (our mouths) gives us instruction and example in order that we may master the use of our words.

A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger. The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness. The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good. A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit. (Proverbs 15:1-4)

The wisdom of the proverbs first points out that we should answer softly for often we may not have all the facts. It could be that, out of control, emotions of another could lead us into reaction rather than response. Misunderstanding can create more misunderstanding. We readily agree that harsh responses in case of provocation or not drive a wedge between communicators.

Wise use of language brings blessings to us and those round about us. The Lord, Himself, is paying attention to the words we use. So many areas of our lives depend heavily upon how and what we communicate. How do we stop those “verbal accidents” when we are tempted? Let’s look to the Creator for our answer.

John chapter eight brings us to a situation where the Son of God was being tempted. The scribes and the Pharisees wanted to see if they could cause Jesus to have a “verbal accident.” It would seem that they had ensnared a woman in the act of adultery. They pressed Jesus for an answer and reminded Him that the Law of Moses stated that the woman should have been stoned. This was yet another attempt to anger Jesus. These students of the law knew that Leviticus 20:10 makes clear that both the man and the woman should be stoned. They were using “half-truth” and innuendo to create an environment that would cause most people to be overwhelmed and react rather than respond.

Jesus shows us a way to handle a pressure filled situation. First, Jesus becomes aware of His thoughts. In a moment of quiet consideration, the Master stoops down and writes on the ground. The Bible does not tell us that Jesus was angry and yet we can see plainly that He was provoked. In those times when we are provoked and feel anger coming we should consider our thoughts. What direction are our thoughts leading us and what will be the outcome? If we are headed in a negative direction that will cause everyone pain, we must change our minds. The first step in avoiding a “verbal accident” is changing our minds. The truth is that there is no such thing as a “verbal accident”. There is only verbiage that is out of control. We hide behind anger as if it were an untamable animal that slips out of its cage every once in a while. This is simply an excuse for deciding not to control our language and responses.

Second, Jesus responds with a question. The wisdom of the Savior is amazing as He challenges the accusers to consider their own accountability. Our wisdom may not be as infinite and yet we can learn from His example. For instance, when pressured, could we ask, “Can we stop for a moment and consider how we got there today?” Rather than accuse the accusers, Jesus allowed them to convict themselves by answering softly with a simple question.

Two keys to successfully using language are taking note of our thoughts before they become public record and responding kindly. Let us put these into practice today.
