At this moment, we need everyone to be praying for this year's VBS. Take a moment, before you continue reading, and pray that we will have great success at VBS for 2017.

Our cruise ship theme will take us to the islands of Knowledge and Obedience as we read last week. There will also be stops on the islands of Perseverance and Hope. The dock of Perseverance captures our attention with all the activity there.

Cruise ships are often loaded with passengers on vacation with desire to see places, people and things they have never seen before. The island of Perseverance is certainly loaded with the uncommon. Vacationers are often characterized as those who are just lying about in the sun. This is not true of the citizens of Perseverance. Here you will find people who continue to live as God's people at rest, at play and at work.

Some take a vacation from God when they take a vacation from work. What would happen if God took a vacation from us? Surely with all the problems in this world, God would deserve a rest. God has persevered to be there for you despite your imperfections. God goes with you everywhere and, despite our difficulties, protects us even from ourselves sometimes. He has given us, however, the power and responsibility of choice. This means that when we are determined to vacate our place before Him, He will not stop us. "And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;" (Romans 1:28). What a terrible thing it would be...Lost forever because we did not show God the same honor He bestows on us.

The seas of life sometimes are troubled and it is in those times we are tempted to take our eyes off the Savior. This is not new.

And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

(Matthew 14:25-32)

Life, work and school for our children can cause us to want and need a well-deserved rest. The Devil will use this time of weariness to create a sense of justification for selfishness. Suddenly we find ourselves justified in separating from friends, family and even God. The drive to press on engaging and serving is gone. When we feel our perseverance failing, this is the time to reach out to God. If we want real rest here is where we find it. "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30).

When we need rest we need to lean on Jesus. He will give us the power we need to persevere and accomplish His will. Perseverance is made easier when we look toward the ultimate rest that is coming. Looking forward is Hope and that will be our next stop.
