

“The Forstbitten Heart”

Our bodies can receive frostbite from being too long in the cold. This extreme cold can feel like, and leave the same damage to the flesh as, a burn. The body has nerve endings that are sensors to signal trouble is occurring. The problem is that when the nerve endings are squelched because of the cold, there is no signal and damage occurs. The easy solution is to react so the nerve endings are never squelched. The problem is that the squelching of the nerves happens so slowly that it is not noticed. The best solution is to protect oneself from the cold altogether even though it might be seen by some as over-reacting. Prevention is the best protection.

The Heart, or conscience, can also suffer from frostbite as Satan tries to keep us away from God in the coldness of the world. Like physical frostbite, the soul is gradually numbed with hurt feelings, apathy or simply inactivity. Without our realizing the damage being done by our absence from God, our Hearts become cold and seared. Soon we can find ourselves falling victim to those who would lead us astray—even those within the house of God. It is there, in the house of God, that Satan does his best work. He never spends time on those who are lost, for he holds the key to their eternal future anyway. His desire is to enter the church through a “harmless” activity or to influence others with gossip and seeds of division. There will be no warning. The damage will be done without notice. Suddenly apostasy is rampant and division is inevitable.

We can see this where worship has become a carnival to entertain the participants rather than to please the Mighty God. One local place of worship is offering the “Chance to Win a Car” for just attending services on December 25th. As far from the truth as that sounds, this did not happen overnight. This variance from focus on the Mighty God came a trickle at a time.

In 1967, a campus ministry at the University of Florida began some peculiar but seemingly harmless prayer partnering within the Lord’s church. These were holding each other accountable for specified time of prayer. The development of a discipleship and mentoring program was taking place. There were also, “Soul Talks” when a mentor would teach a small group one night during the week. The encouragement was wonderful... but there was a movement underway. Those who were taken in could not understand why anyone would object. Fundamentally, Satan used something as pure as prayer to gain momentum. Soon another group would follow in similar pattern. Having been trained by those in Gainesville, Florida, this new group claimed to refine the movement found at the Crossroads congregation. Satan’s plan, now revealed, was to build an alliance with numbers. When it comes to departure from Truth, there is power in numbers. “Certainly, a large group could not be wrong” (Exodus 23:2).

These would be led in acceptance, and then denial, that something as pure as prayer could be tainted with evil. This movement would seek to oust elders who resisted the introduction of the new church organization underway. Fundamentally, this movement sought to undermine God-designed church leadership. Elders were criticized for a lack of vision, accountability, and action. Congregations were charged with a lack of spirituality. If you did not get with the new program, you were out.

College students were the first prey of this emotionally-charged evangelistic movement. The new organization would be directed mostly from very large host congregations in larger cities. Though fantastic oration would hide it, most of the direction would come from a few dynamic speakers. Problems arose when Christian behavior began being defined by the leader or leaders rather than by God’s word. Cultish abuse took place in the manipulation of private lives. The over-reach came with a host of problems created by an organization that sought to control rather than to teach the Truth. Those who would not conform or questioned the design would find themselves berated and shamed. Division was inevitable.

Over the decades, a clear distinction between the Lord’s church and those of the “Boston Movement” and the “Crossroads Movement” emerged. The International Churches of Christ was established with a leader, other than Christ, at the helm. Like frostbite, by the time most realized what was happening the damage had been done.

Satan is not done with this idea because it works so well. We have threats coming our way consistently and most likely do not see them. The Devil is alive and well without anything new under the sun, just new to us. If someone invites you to some sort of private prayer group, rest assured that trouble and division is on the horizon. Please notice the warnings we find in God’s word.

Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravaging wolves. (Matthew 7:15)


