

Stay Out of the Street!

It was an apartment complex like many others. Two mothers lived across the walkway from one another. Their names were Kim and Sally. Both had husbands that worked hard. When they grilled out together, as they often did in the walkway, they shared their dreams. They hoped that their families would always live close together because they had become such great friends. Their dreams included that someday both young families would live in a neighborhood with more room for the kids to run and play. With space being tight right now, Kim and Sally would trade off playground watch over the children. The greatest challenge seemed to be keeping the children from playing in the street while they made their way back and forth from the playground.

Handling this challenge brought out two very different parenting styles. On the way to the playground when Kim had this issue she would forcefully exclaim to the children they could not play in the street. If they ignored her, she would make them sit at the playground and watch the others play for about half the time they were there. Sally, on the other hand, would repeatedly beg the children to no avail. Sally was often anxious and afraid on the trip back and forth. When Sally had the children at the playground, she would talk with other mothers, catch up on facebook with her phone, or read a book. She just wanted to relax after that worrisome walk. After a couple years the children always followed Kim's directions but viewed her as "uptight" and "over-reactive". All the children would share these things with Sally, buttering her up as the "cool" mom.

About the time the children were in middle school, both families found homes in safe neighborhoods only separated by two streets. Life seemed to be perfect for these great families as they grew as friends. Their children went to school together, both families went to church together and even went on vacations together.

All that time together brought out even more the difference in their parenting styles. Sally often thought that Kim was just too hard on the kids. "They are kids after all. Sometimes you just can't do anything with them," Sally would claim. She did not recognize, however, how frazzled she was after spending a great deal of time with all the children. Perhaps some of the reason Sally was so frazzled was because she did not like being "the bad guy" and discipline the children. Therefore she would give them directions and then her attention would go elsewhere so as not to notice. Sally just did not want to have to work at keeping the children within the given parameters consistently. The children knew that even if she did notice them outside the given parameters, Sally would straighten out the problems herself giving excuse for the children and taking the responsibility herself. This would follow with a yelling session from Sally and then she would buy them all pizza because she felt bad for losing her temper.

Kim, on the other hand, never seemed to be all that frazzled. All the children followed her direction because her own children would say, "Making Mom mad never turns out good for anyone." The children knew that Kim loved them dearly. That meant she had a great deal of work while the children were small. There was a phase of testing Kim and her consistency. And there was another phase of discovering their antics. Kim was determined to have a positive influence on the children. Teaching them to respect her, meant that Kim taught the children to respect others as well. Kim's hard work paid off when the children arrived at the teen years. Certainly as children do, they made a few bad decisions but not near as many as those children without a disciplined influence. Love is displayed by consistently providing parameters for children. As the children grew older they grew much closer to Kim. Maturity is often drawn to wisdom.

It seems the Proverb is true. "Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart" (Proverbs 29:17).
