Sail Away with Us!

Vacation Bible School is almost here. Remember to invite everyone you know to join YOU each night from June 19th to the 23rd. The cruise ship of study will land us on the islands of Knowledge, Obedience, Perseverance and Hope.

Over the last few weeks we have considered the need to take treasures from the islands of Knowledge, Obedience and Perseverance. The final stop on our tour rests on Hope. The way we use the word "Hope" and the way the New Testament writers used that word is very different.

Fundamentally we use the word "Hope" today as a weak wish. Some would say, "I hope for world peace." or "I hope for plenty of rain this summer." Tossing a coin into a wish pond fits the way we use this word commonly today. Notice Webster's definitions of "Hope."

Noun:

A feeling of expectation and desire for a certain thing to happen.
 "He looked through her belongings in the hope of coming across some information."

Synonyms:

Aspiration, desire, wish, expectation, ambition, aim, goal, plan, design, dream, daydream, pipe dream
 "I had high hopes."

Archaic:

A feeling of trust.

Verb:

A want for something to happen or be the case.
 "He is hoping for an offer of compensation."

Notice that Webster only uses the word "expectation" in conjunction with "desire" as if expectation cannot be assuredness. Notice also the list of synonyms includes: wish, dream, daydream, and pipe dream. The "Archaic" use of the word is the underlying idea that the New Testament writers had in mind along with expectation.

Within the pages of God's Word we see that in every case God has kept His promises. We are living in a time of His grace, mercy and patience till His final promise is done. This promise is found in several New Testament passages.

For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works. (Matthew 16:27)

And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. (Matthew 24:30-31)

Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh. (Matthew 25:13)

Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. (John 14:1-3)

Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. (Revelation 1:7)

And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last. (Revelation 22:12-13)

These passages, along with many others, provide Hope for the Christian. Not just a wish but an assuredness that Jesus will return and in judgement will take the faithful to His place of rest. This is a Hope that removes all fear and all doubt. The Christian has Hope an expectation that Jesus will keep this promise as every promise before has been kept by God. You can smile as one of God's faithful no matter what comes your way.
